

COCHRANE TO HARMONY TRAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY:

HOLDING STATEMENT FOR STAPA, ALBERTA

Springbank Trails and Pathways Association and its project partners are currently undertaking an early Feasibility Study for a potential multi-use pathway connection between Cochrane and Harmony.

The study is looking at whether a practical and feasible alignment may be possible, including technical, infrastructure, landowner and municipal considerations.

No final alignment has been selected, and no approvals, funding or construction timeline have been confirmed.

At this stage, the project team is focused on understanding feasibility and speaking with directly relevant municipal representatives, technical stakeholders and landowners. If the project advances beyond feasibility, additional communication and engagement would be expected.
